The following is an update to appointments for the 2025-2026 pastoral year, effective March 1, 2026, unless otherwise noted:

Deanery 1


- **Fr. Nick Ferreras** will serve as Chaplain to the Rose Garden Hospice in Prince Albert visiting twice a week and being on call for anointing and emergencies. He will continue as full-time Chaplain of the Victoria Hospital in Prince Albert, Chaplain of Pineview Terrace with Mass and visits alternating weekly on Wednesdays and provide Sunday replacement ministry for Pastors.
- **Fr. Travis Myrheim** has been serving as a Correctional Chaplain at the Saskatchewan Penitentiary in Prince Albert every Tuesday since April 2025 and will continue to do so. He will also continue to serve as Rector of Sacred Heart Cathedral in Prince Albert, Chaplain of École St. Mary High, École St. Anne and École Valois schools, will celebrate Saturday Mass at the Columbian Centre, and serve as Vocations Director for the Diocese.
- **Fr. Marco Ladao** will continue to serve as Pastoral Associate of Sacred Heart Cathedral in Prince Albert who under the direction of the Rector will share in the appointed ministry to the parish, schools, and senior home. He will also continue to serve as the Spiritual Advisor to the Filipino community in Prince Albert and area with monthly Mass at St. Joseph in Prince Albert, Chaplain to the Herb Bassett Home with Mass and visits alternating weekly on Wednesdays, and assist the Chaplain of the Victoria Hospital by replacing him on days off and for vacation time.
- **Fr. DJ Vu** will serve as Administrator of St. James in Albertville and the Mission of St. James in Candle Lake. He will continue to serve as Pastor of St. Mark in Prince Albert, which includes celebrating Mass once a month at River Breeze Retirement Complex, Carment Court, Good Shepherd Villas, and serving as Chaplain of St. John Community School.
- **Fr. Tuyen Vu** will provide Mass on Thursdays and Sundays at Mont St. Joseph Home and work with the Mont St. Joseph Director of Chaplaincy when needed, including being on call for anointing and emergencies. He will continue to serve as Acting Chaplain of the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary 3101 Infirmary in Prince Albert with Mass on 3 weekdays and on Sunday and be on call for anointing and emergencies.
- **All Priests of the Deanery** will attend Deanery Meetings and help with Sacrament of Reconciliation in the parishes and schools during Lent and Advent.

Other

- **Fr. Asantha Jude Perera, TOR:** We welcome Fr. Jude from the Franciscan Congregation in Sri Lanka who is staying with Fr. Roger Paponette in Duck Lake temporarily to support his transition to Canada in preparation to serve in the Diocese of Prince Albert.
